

Report of the Parish Council Meeting 18th November 2020

OPENING: The Meeting was opened at 7.00 pm, by the Chairman Cllr. A. Percy

MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 21st October 2020: The Minutes were approved and signed as True Records.

MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES OF 21st October 2020:

The Clerk informed the meeting that he has raised the issue of Parking with parking enforcement. A reply has been received indicating that they will schedule some patrols. Cllr. A. Percy gave an update on the Community Network Highways Budget allocation – We are unlikely to get the widening of the kerbs on the shops side of Holywell Road but may get the additional dropped kerbs that we are requesting.

Cllr. A. Percy reported on the continuing argument with Cornwall Council over the Colan Section 106 for affordable housing. An internal review of this matter has now been requested. Cllr. A. Percy will be updating the other Parish and Town councils on the replies received to date.

Cllr. A. Percy further reported that we should receive a decision on our funding application for the proposed cycle track in the QEII park soon.

Cubert Toilet refurbishment – The Parish Council is still trying to get quotes at present.

FINANCE: To ratify delegated decisions for November - RESOLVED: To ratify the delegated decisions for October. The Quarterly Audit has been completed with no matters arising. The accounts have been emailed to all Councillors for inspection.
