**PARISH COUNCIL PRECEPT 2025/26** - The figures were circulated and a lengthy debate took place regarding the level of Precept for 25/26. Particular consideration was given to the reduction in the Street Cleansing Grant and how this would affect the Precept. To cover the reduction, a Precept of £38,500 is required. This equates to a decrease of £0.06 per annum on a Band D property. **RESOLVED:** The Parish Precept be set at **£38,500** for 25/26.
